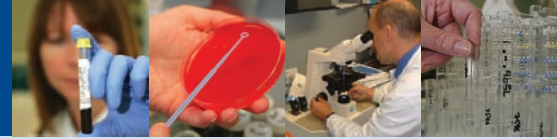


Clinical Skills Centre



The Beardmore Centre for Health Science's Clinical Skills Centre will provide a high quality tailored environment for the delivery of both clinical and general training to all health care professionals by:

- enhancing the clinical skills training experience through the provision of two single bedroom ward simulation areas;
- providing a dedicated facility for clinical skills training involving the use of a patient simulator; and
- enhancing surgical skills training through a purpose-built area with the ability to live stream surgical procedures from the hospital theatres and cardiac catheterisation laboratories.

The Centre Manager will coordinate the needs of all clients and work closely with The Beardmore Hotel and Conference Centre's events team to provide the most suitable training schedule to match your requirements.

Facilities

Training Rooms 1 and 2:

These training rooms have been designed for hospital-based manual handling and resuscitation training. Both rooms are modelled on the Golden Jubilee National Hospital's single rooms and can therefore be used to provide any training requiring a ward-like environment. All of the furniture can be removed to enable conference-style training to take place. A flexible wall between the two rooms can also be removed to provide a larger training space.

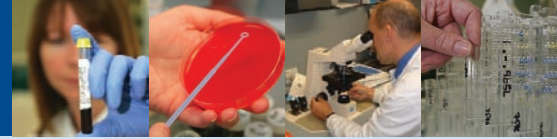
Built-in audio visual (AV) and information technology (IT) will include:

- smart board;
- ceiling-mounted data projector;
- projection screen;
- white board; and
- network connections.

Flip charts and laptops connected to the Internet can also be supplied if required.

Training Room 3:

This training room is designed to house the Patient Simulator and provide a suitable environment for training which requires the use of this equipment.



Training Room 4:

This room is designed for conference-style training and can be set up in a variety of layouts for up to 24 delegates. This room also has a storage area for 25 laptops which can be used for training in any room within the Centre.

Built-in AV and IT will include:

- smart board;
- ceiling-mounted data projector;
- projection screen;
- white board; and
- network connections.

Flip charts and laptops connected to the Internet can also be supplied if required.

Training Room 5

This specialist training room is designed for surgical skills training and has space for six theatre-style platforms with one central platform for the use of the trainer, and can also be used for conference-style training.

As training materials will include artificial human body parts, this training room also has a preparation room with storage refrigerators and a transition area to allow delegates to change from outdoor clothing.

This room will also have the capability of viewing live surgical procedures being carried out within the Golden Jubilee National Hospital's orthopaedic and cardiothoracic theatres and the cath labs.

Built-in AV and IT will include:

- flat screen monitor;
- smart board;
- ceiling-mounted data projector;
- projection screen;
- white board; and
- network connections.

Flip charts and laptops connected to the Internet can also be supplied if required. Support will also be available from the Beardmore Hotel and Conference Centre's events team for IT/AV needs.
